In addition, the Cowley Distribution Centre was one of only six organisations worldwide to achieve the double award for excellence in winning both the Sword of Honour and the Globe of Honour. The Globe of Honour award scheme was launched in 2010 to recognise exemplary environmental management. The winners have to complete the British Safety Council's five star environmental audit before demonstrating that they go beyond compliance and strive for best practice in all areas of environmental management.

Announcing the results, Alex Botha, chief executive of the British Safety Council said, "On behalf of the British Safety Council, I warmly congratulate the winning organisations and their employees. The winning organisations came from a wide range of sectors ...what unites them is their shared belief that proportionate and competent risk management brings both financial and social benefits to their organisations"
