- the E-Fulfilment, Distribution and Returns Centre at Magna Park in Leicestershire
- the Distribution Centre at Honeybourne in Worcestershire
- the Global Distribution Centre at Baginton in Coventry
- the Oxford Distribution Centre

In addition, the Oxford Distribution Centre was one of only seven organisations worldwide to achieve the double award for excellence in winning both the Sword of Honour and the Globe of Honour. The Globe of Honour award scheme was launched in 2010 to recognise exemplary environmental management. The winners have to complete the British Safety Council's five star environmental audit before demonstrating that they go beyond compliance and strive for best practice in all areas of environmental management.
